

Discussion Questions (4-25-2010):

1. Just dream for a couple of minutes. What would you do if you had unlimited financial resources?
2. Why do you think it is so difficult to make changes in virtually every area of our lives on our own? Why do you think people generally feel they need to make changes in their lives on their own? What margin of success have you been able to have making changes in your life when you are doing it alone?
3. Read John 7:37-39. This is Jesus speaking. What is it that He is promising will happen if we will “come to Him”? Why do you think this is so important in our lives? How will this help you when you are trying to become “The Me I Want To Be”?
4. I made a statement this week, “Self-Improvement is no more God’s plan than “Self-Salvation”. How have you seen this to be true in your life? Read Ephesians 2:10. Who really “owns” the work that is being done in us?
5. Read Ephesians 3:14-19. When you read these verses and learn what Paul was praying for the church at Ephesus; what do you learn about the resource we have in God?
6. This week we talked about these “Unlimited Resources”:

Power of the Spirit

Love of the Son

Fullness of the Father

Which of these was the most important for you to learn and be reminded of?
Why?

7. Read Psalm 42:1. The psalmist is speaking of a desperate passion for God. Do you have a similar passion?
8. So often in our culture we perceive “surrender” to be defeat. What kind of impact has this made in our lives spiritually? We also learned that surrender, in a Spiritual sense, is really that only way to victory. In light of what we are learning in our series, “The Me I Want To Be” and this week’s study on “God’s Unlimited Resources”; why is it so important to learn to surrender?
